Introductory Note

It is a legal requirement for parishes to hold a village meeting once a year between 01 March and 30 June. Parish Councils are not legally bound to organise the meeting, though most, including Levens, traditionally accept the responsibility for doing so. Where there is a Parish Council, the Chair of the Council will preside and the agenda must include reports on Parish Council business over the previous 12 months, including finance. In addition to delivering the legal requirements, Annual Parish Meetings also provide an opportunity for parishioners to catch-up on local matters and to hear about the activities of voluntary or local community groups. Annual Parish Meetings often include a slot for a guest speaker to give a short presentation on a topic of local interest.
